The partnership is proud of the family wage, Health & Welfare and Pension plans our electricians earn and in return, we expect our electricians to work their full hours.

Notifying supervisors that you are leaving the job site is more than a common courtesy, it is another matter of safety. To help ensure the safety and wellbeing of every person on a job site, supervisors need to know where everyone is and what they are doing.
