## What is an apprentice?

An electrical **apprentice** is someone who is learning the electrical trade through classroom instruction and by working on the job alongside journey workers.

A **journey level worker** is someone who has completed their apprenticeship and carries an electrical license to perform electrical work unsupervised.

Once accepted into our apprenticeship program, we will provide you with two weeks of Basic Skills training. We will then place you with an employer and you will earn wages, health care benefits, and retirement benefits while you complete your on-the-job training.

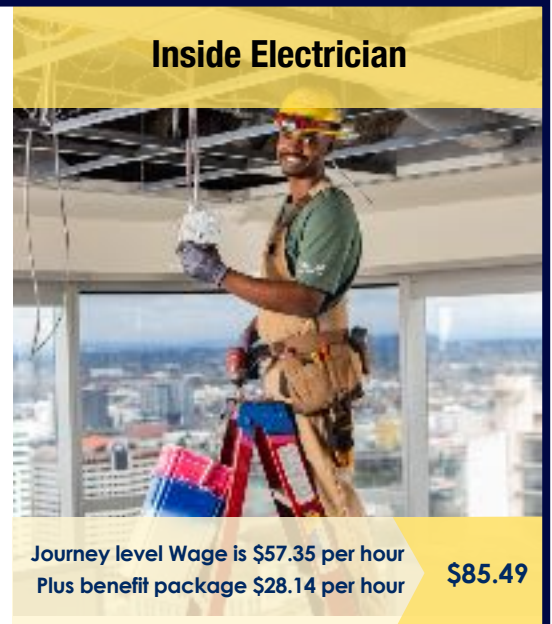
