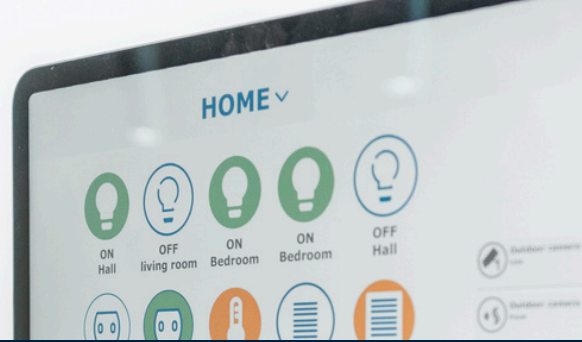


Planning Your Smart Home Transformation
