## Setting Up Your Facebook Business Page

Your Facebook Business Page is your digital storefront. It should immediately communicate professionalism and reliability. **Include:**

<p><b>BUSINESS NAME, PHONE NUMBER, AND SERVICE AREA</b></p>	<p><b>HIGH-QUALITY IMAGES (TRUCK, TEAM, COMPLETED WORK)</b></p>
<p><b>CLEAR LIST OF SERVICES (REPAIRS, INSTALLATIONS, UPGRADES)</b></p>	<p><b>CALL-TO-ACTION BUTTON (CALL NOW, MESSAGE, BOOK NOW)</b></p>

A strong page builds trust before the first interaction.

### BUILD YOUR CAMPAIGN

Choose campaign objectives that align with how customers hire electricians:

- **LEAD GENERATION**  
Capture customer details for estimates and service calls.
- **TRAFFIC**  
Send users to your website for more information on services.
- **MESSAGES**  
Encourage direct inquiries, especially useful for urgent jobs.
- **REACH & AWARENESS**  
Keep your business visible to as many local people as possible.

### CHOOSE YOUR TARGET AUDIENCE

Effective targeting ensures your ads reach the right people.

- **FOCUS ON YOUR SERVICE AREA**  
Target specific cities or ZIP codes to avoid wasted ad spend.
- **RECONNECT WITH EXISTING CUSTOMERS**  
Promote maintenance services, inspections, or upgrades to past clients.
- **ENGAGE WARM AUDIENCES**  
Target people who have interacted with your page or website. These users are more likely to convert.
- **REACH NEW CUSTOMERS**  
Expand to homeowners and property managers in your area with clear, direct messaging about your services.

## Create High-Performing Ad Content

Your ads should reflect what customers care about most: safety, speed, and trust.

 <p><b>USE REAL PHOTOS</b></p> <p>Show your team, your truck, or actual job sites. Authentic visuals outperform generic stock images.</p>	 <p><b>HIGHLIGHT KEY SERVICES</b></p> <p>Focus on common, high-demand jobs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Electrical repairs</li> <li>– Panel upgrades</li> <li>– Lighting installation</li> <li>– Panel upgrades</li> <li>– Lighting installation</li> </ul>	 <p><b>WRITE CLEAR, DIRECT COPY</b></p> <p>Keep it simple:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– What you do</li> <li>– Who you help</li> <li>– How to contact you</li> </ul>	 <p><b>INCLUDE A STRONG CALL TO ACTION</b></p> <p>Include a Strong Call to Action</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– "Call now for fast service."</li> <li>– "Book your appointment today."</li> <li>– "Message us for a free estimate."</li> </ul>
